

## AVA KATE

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 70" x 70"
Finished Block Size $81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Ava Kate 10" Stacker (10-10530-42)
1¼ yards Black Main (C10530 Black)
2³/4 yards Putty Solid (C120 Putty)
$5 / 8$ yard Binding

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.
WOF - width of fabric.

Label pieces as they are cut.

## Ava Kate 10" Stacker

Select 25 squares for the crosses.
Sub-cut from each square:
$1-3 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 9 \frac{112 " 1}{}$ rectangle (E)
2-31/2" squares (F)
Keep the E and F pieces from each square together as a set.
Select 16 squares for the squares between the crosses.
Sub-cut from each square:

1-61 / 2 \text { square (D) }
$$

## Black Main

Cut 7 strips $51 / 2 \mathrm{x} \times$ WOF for Border.

## Putty Solid

Cut 2 strips 14" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
4-14" squares, cut on both diagonals for 16 triangles (G)

2-71/2" squares, cut on one diagonal for 4 triangles (H) Cut 4 strips 5½" x WOF.

## Sub-cut from strips:

25-51/2" squares, cut on both diagonals for 100
triangles (B)
Cut 4 strips 51⁄8" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
$32-51 / 8$ " squares, cut on one diagonal for 64 triangles
(A)

Cut 4 strips 3" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
50-3" squares, cut on one diagonal for 100 triangles
(C)

## Binding

Cut 8 strips $2 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Binding.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of prints. Press as shown.

## Cross Blocks (Make 25)

Select the following pieces:
Cross - 1 set of E rectangle and F squares
Background - 4 B and 4 C triangles
Sew a B triangle to each side of 1 F square to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit A's.


Sew a Unit A to each side of the E rectangle to create Unit B.


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Sew a C triangle on each corner of the Unit B to create a Cross Block (9" x 9").


Cross Block
Repeat to make 25 Cross Blocks.

## Square in a Square Block (Make 16)

Select the following pieces:

## Center-1 D square

Background - 4 A triangles

Sew 2 A triangles to opposite sides of the D square.


Sew the remaining 2 A triangles to the remaining sides to create a Square in a Square Block (9" x 9").


Square in a Square Block
Repeat to make 16 Square in a Square Blocks.

## Quilt Center

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram (page 3) for Cross Block, Square in a Square Block, and setting triangle placement.

Sew the Blocks and G and H Triangles together in diagonal rows. Press the seam allowances away from the Cross Blocks.

Sew the Rows together to make the Quilt Center.
Triangles G and H were intentionally cut large. Square the center by trimming the excess leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowance from the blocks on all sides ( $605 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 605 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ).


## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting horizontal sashing and border pieces.

Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to cut border strips. Sew side borders first.

Side borders should be $605 / 8^{\prime \prime}$. Top and bottom borders should be $70 \% 8^{\prime \prime}$.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Ava Kate print. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
