

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 60" x 80"

Finished Block Size 20" x 20"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Fat Quarter of each:

Rose Victoria Floral

Lavender Feather Dance

Rose Kew Trellis

Charcoal Manor Tile

Lavender Cambridge Fern

Rose Cambridge Fern

Lavender Topiary Chevron

Rose Oxford Fern

Rose Conservatory Fruits

Other Fabrics:

2 yards C120 Cloud Solid ¾ yard Gray Hampton Vines ¾ yard charcoal Hidcote Berry Binding ¾ yard (70 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.

¾ yard Gray Hampton Vines


Cut 5 strips 5" x WOF. Cut strips into 35-5" squares. Place 33 squares into a stack (#1) and place 2 squares into a seperate stack (#2).

¾ yard Charcoal Hidcote Berry

Cut 5 strips 5" x WOF. Cut strips into 36-5" squares. Place 33 squares into a stack (#1) and place 3 squares into a seperate stack (#2).

Fat Quarter Stack

Use the cutting diagram to carefully cut the following pieces. In order to get the pieces from a fat quarter, you will have to cut one of the 5" squares from the 13" square that gets cut once diagonally for some of the prints.



Cutting Diagram

Cut a square 13" x 13" from each of the following assorted prints. Cut the square once diagonally to create two large triangles from each print.

Lavender Cambridge Fern (1), Rose Cambridge Fern (1), Rose Oxford Fern (1), Lavender Topiary Chevron (1), Rose Victoria Floral, Rose Kew Trellis, Charcoal Manor Tile, Lavender Feather Dance and Rose Conservatory Fruits. *NOTE: You will only need one of the triangles in four of the prints.

Cut squares 5" x 5" from the remaining assorted prints, for a total of 54-5" squares and place in stack #2.

Cloud Solid

Cut 2 strips 13" x WOF. Cut the strips into 6 squares 13" x 13". Cut each square once diagonally to create 12 large triangles.

Cut 8 strips 5" x WOF. Cut the strips into 63 squares 5" x 5".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

Dalliance Block

Sew a large assorted print triangle to a large cloud solid triangle to create a Large Half Square Triangle. Press. Square up to 12½". Repeat to create 12 Large Half Square Triangles.



Large Half Square Triangle

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a cloud solid 5" square. Place a cloud solid 5" square on top of an assorted print 5" square. Sew ¼" on each side of the line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Square up the Half Square Triangles to 4½". Repeat to make 126 Half Square Triangles.



Half Square Triangle

Repeat the steps above to create 66 Half Square Triangles from the 5" squares of Gray Hampton Vines and Charcoal Hidcote Berry squares.



Half Square Triangle


This part of the instructions is for 1 block. Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Half Square Triangle placement. Sew 3 assorted print Half Square Triangle Units together to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 assorted print Unit As.



Sew 5 assorted print Half Square Triangle Units together to create Unit B. Repeat to create 2 assorted print Unit Bs.



Sew a Unit A to each side of a Large Half Square Triangle to create the Center Unit.



Center Unit

Sew a Unit B to the top and bottom of the Center Unit to complete the Dalliance Block. Repeat to create 12 Dalliance Blocks.

Quilt Center Assembly

Lay out the Dalliance Blocks in 4 rows of 3 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Liberty fabric from The Summer House Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
