# FINISHED QUILT SIZE 76" x 76" (1.93m x 1.93m)

Finished Block Size 16" x 16" (41cm x 41cm)

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

# **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

¾ Yard (65cm) 04775663X Green Festive Cheer
1¾ Yards (1.5m) 04775661X Pink/Green Holiday Berries
(Includes Binding)

3¼ Yards (3m) 04775665X Silver/White Frosty (Background)

2 Yards (1.85m) 04775666X Green Sparkling Forest (Includes Border)

3/8 Yard (35cm) 04775664Y Green/Pink Festive Shine 7/8 Yard (85cm) 04775662X Pink/Green Poinsettia 1/4 Yard (25cm) 04775667X Silver on White Wiltshire Shade

#### **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

## Green Festive Cheer:

Cut 3 squares 8½" x 8½" Cut 25 squares 4½" x 4½"

Cut 8 squares 2½" x 2½"

## Holiday Berries Pink/Green:

Cut 2 squares 8½" x 8½"

Cut 22 squares 4½" x 4½"

Cut 48 squares 2½" x 2½"

# Festive Shine Green/Pink & Metallic Gold:

Cut 1 square 8½" x 8½"

Cut 11 squares 4½" x 4½"

Cut 24 squares 2½" x 2½"

## Poinsettia Pink/Green:

Cut 4 squares 8½" x 8½"

Cut 33 squares 4½" x 4½"

Cut 8 squares 2½" x 2½"

#### Wiltshire Shade Silver Metallic on White:

Cut 3 squares 4½" x 4½"

Cut 24 squares 2½" x 2½"

# **Green Sparkling Forest:**

Cut 2 squares 8½" x 8½"

Cut 18 squares 4½" x 4½"

Cut 16 squares 2½" x 2½"

Cut 8 strips 6 ½" x WOF for the border

# Frosty Silver Metallic on White

Cut 6 strips  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 6 strips  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 rectangles  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 4 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 64 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 4 strips 4%" x WOF. Cut the strips into 64 rectangles 2%" x 4%".

#### QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

## Large Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 assorted print 4%" squares. Place an assorted print 4%" square on top of a cream petal 4%" x 8%" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a %" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left side and right side of an assorted print 8½" square to create the Center Unit.

Center Unit

Sew a cream petal 4½" square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit As.

Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of the Center Unit to complete the Large Star Block. Repeat to make 12 Large Star Blocks.

#### Four Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 assorted print 2%" squares. Place an assorted print 2%" square on top of a cream petal 2%" x 4%" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a %" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left side and right side of an assorted print 4½" square to create the Center Unit.

Sew a cream petal 2½" square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit As.




Unit A

Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of the Center Unit to complete the Star Unit. Repeat to make 4 Star Units (1 each from rose leaf, blue circles, red petal, and green knot).

Sew the 4 Star Units together to create the Four Star Block. Repeat to make 4 Four Star Blocks.

## **Quilt Center Assembly**

See the Quilt Center Diagram for Large Star and Four Star Block placement. Lay out the blocks in 4 rows of 4 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

# **Borders**

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be 64½". Top and bottom borders should be 76½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Era of Jane Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
