FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 52" × 60"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

10" Stacker Sense & Sensibility (10-C12820-42)

½ yard each of:

Colonel Brandon (C12833)

Correspondence (C10018)

Henry (C127832) Binding

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

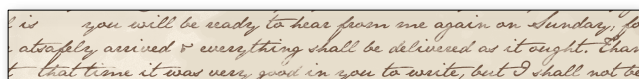
Please read instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics.



Colonel Brandon

Cut 2 strips 6" × WOF; subcut:

14- 6" squares



Correspondence

Cut 2 strips 6" × WOF; subcut:

14- 6" squares



Henry

Cut 6 strips × WOF for binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

- Refer to the cutting requirements list, quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints.
- Follow pressing arrows for successful piecing.
- All Half-Square Triangles (HST) are constructed using the Magic 8 method. The method is explained below and referenced throughout the pattern.

Magic 8 Method

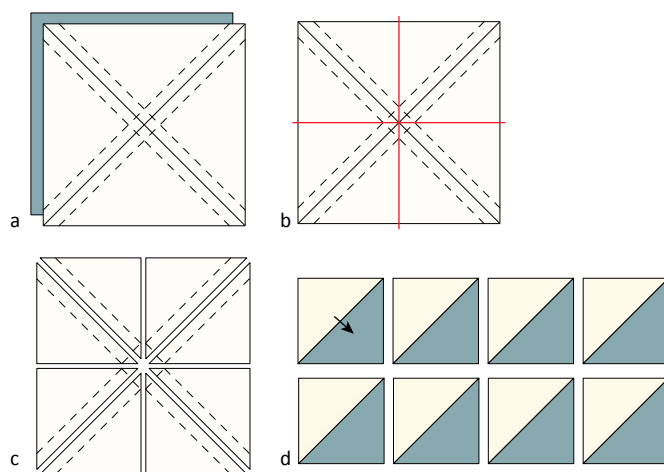
Pair 2 equal-sized squares right sides together.

Draw 2 diagonal lines from corner to corner on the wrong side of the lighter square.

Sew a scant ¼" on each side of the drawn lines (a).

Without disturbing the fabric, cut the sewn squares in half once horizontally, and once vertically (b), and twice on the diagonal (c). Open and press to the dark fabric.

You will have 8 HSTs (d). Square-up as necessary.



Half-Square Triangles (HST)

Match up all the squares in the 10" Stacker into 21 pairs.

Using the Magic 8 method, make 8 HSTs from each pair. You will have a total of 168- 4½" HSTs.

Quilt Center

Sew together side-to-side in a row, 12 HSTs, alternating the orientation every other block. Make 7 rows starting with a left-slanting HST, and 7 starting with a right-slanting HST.

Sew rows together, alternating left- and right-slanting rows to complete the Quilt Center (48½" × 56½").

Outer Border

Match up the 6" Colonel Brandon and Correspondence squares into 14 pairs.

Using the Magic 8 method, make 8 HSTs from each pair. You will need a total of 108- 2½" HSTs.

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Sew together 28 of the 2½" HSTs in a column for the side borders, paying attention to the block orientation for the left and right sides. Sew these to the quilt sides.

Repeat this step, making 2 rows of 26 HSTs each for the top and bottom borders. Sew these to the quilt. Quilt measures 52½" × 60½".

FINISHING

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Quilt as desired. Bind with 2½" Henry strips.
