




A Garden for Harper

Pattern by *moda*

Quilt is 72" x 72"



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Prints:** 1 Jelly Roll*
- Background:** 1 solid Jelly Roll plus
1/2 yard same fabric
- Binding:** 3/4 yard
- Backing:** 4 1/2 yards

*Jelly Roll = 40 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips

A Garden for Harper Quilt is 72" x 72"



CUTTING

BACKGROUND (use 3 strips from background Jelly Roll and 6 strips from 1/2 yard)

Subcut 9-2 1/2" x WOF strips into 72-2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.

BINDING

8-2 1/2" x width of fabric strips

Sew the 8 strips end to end to make the binding.


CONSTRUCTION Use 1/4" seams and press in the direction of the arrows.

1. To make one block:


(A) Join 1 print and 1 background 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Cut the strip set into 8-2 1/2" and 4-4 1/2" wide segments. Join 2-2 1/2" wide segments. Make 3. Join 1-2 1/2" segment and 1-4 1/2" x 2 1/2" background rectangle. Make 2.





2. Arrange and sew 6 rows in 6 blocks each as shown. Alternate direction of the blocks so that each 2x2 block section creates a 'circle' in the center of background fabric.



3. Press the seams in opposite direction from row to row. Join the rows. Layer, quilt and bind.



(B) Arrange and sew the units in rows as shown. Join the rows to make 1 block. Repeat to make 36 blocks.



Block
12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.
Make 36.
