F	7 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (binding)









Quilt Center:

Assemble the Quilt Center. Press seams open.

Quilt Center should measure 36 1/2" x 48 1/2".





Inner Borders:

Pay close attention to the direction of Fabric E!

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric D squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the bottom left corner of a Fabric E strip.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom right corner.

Top Inner Border should measure $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $44 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make one.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on the top left corner of a Fabric E strip.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Bottom Inner Border should measure $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $44 \frac{1}{2}$ ".




