


Unfinished Block Size: 24 1/2" x 26 1/2"

Roof Side: Scrappy Fabrics (cut each Fabric A & Fabric B from the same print)	Α	1	9	6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle
	В	1	9	6 ½" square
Roof Front, Chimney, Bricks and Cornerstones: Scrappy Fabrics (use as many or as few as you like)	С	1	9	6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle
	D	8	72	4 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle
	E	7	79	4 ½" square
Background & Borders: 6 ½ yards	F	2	18	6 ½" square
	G	1	9	4 ½" x 14 ½" rectangle
	Н	1	9	4 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle
	I	1	9	4 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle
	J	-	12	4 ½" x 24 ½" strip
	K	-	12	4 ½" x 26 ½" strip
	L	-	11	4 ½" x width of fabric strip
Binding: 1 yard	М	-	11	2 ½" x width of fabric strip

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout. Fabric placement is intended to be scrappy.

Big Block Assembly:

Assemble Unit.

Chimney Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 24 1/2".





Make 1 for each block. Make 9 total.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric F and Fabric B squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on the left end of a Fabric C rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the right end with a Fabric B square.

Roof Front Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 12 1/2".





Make 1 for each block. Make 9 total.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on the right end of a Fabric A rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

Roof Side Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 12 1/2".








Assemble Unit using matching fabric.


Roof Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 24 1/2".






Assemble Unit.

Attic Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 24 1/2".





Make 1 for each block. Make 9 total.

Assemble Unit.

Top Floor Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 24 1/2".




Make 1 for each block.

Bottom Floor Unit should measure 8 1/2" x 24 1/2".






Make 1 for each block. Make 9 total.

Assemble Block.


Big Brick House Block should measure 24 1/2" x 26 1/2".





Big Brick House Quilt Center:

Assemble Quilt Center. Press toward the background. Quilt Center should measure 88 ½" x 94 ½".




Big Brick House Borders:

Piece the Fabric L strips end to end and subcut into:

- 2 4 1/2" x 94 1/2" (Side Borders L1)
- 2 4 1/2" x 96 1/2" (Top and Bottom Borders L2))

Attach the Side Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Borders.



Big Brick House Finishing:

Piece the Fabric M strips end to end for binding. Quilt and bind as desired.
