#### FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 72"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

**WOF** = Width of Fabric **RST** = Right Sides Together

#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

- (1) Kindness Always Rolie Polie (RP-13020-40)
- (1) Kindness Always 5" Stacker (5-13020-42)
- 2½ yards Confetti Cotton (C120- Cloud) % yard Tonal (C13024-Navy) for binding

#### **OTHER SUPPLIES**

Basic Sewing Supplies 3¾ yards Backing 66" x 80" piece of Batting

#### **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting Instructions are based on 42" WOF.
- Refer to the guilt photo for the placement of fabrics.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut fabrics.
- Orient the pieces according to their pertinent diagrams. Doing so is essential to following relational instructions such as top, bottom, left, right and so on.
- Follow diagram pressing arrows for successful piecing.
- Label pieces as you cut.

#### **Cloud Confetti Cotton**

Cut 9 strips 2½" x WOF; subcut:

(25) 2½" x 12½" sashing strips

Cut 9 strips 2½" x WOF.

Cut 15 strips 2¼" x WOF; subcut:

(40) 21/4" x 5" rectangles

(40) 2¼" x 8½" rectangles

#### **Navy Tonal**

Cut (7) 2½" x WOF strips for binding.

#### QUILT CONSTRUCTION

#### Strip Sets

1. Select two different 2½" strips from the Kindness Always Rolie Polie and sew them together lengthwise to make Strip Set A (4½" x WOF). Make 15 Strip Sets A.

2. Sew (2) Strip Sets A together lengthwise to make Strip Set B (8½" x WOF). Make 6 Strip Sets B.

3. Sew a Strip Set A and a Strip Set B together lengthwise to make a Strip Set C (12½" x WOF). Make 3 Strip Sets C.

4. Subcut Strip Sets B into (40) 2½" x 8½" segments D.

5. Subcut Strip Sets C into (40) 2%" x 12%" segments E.




#### **Blocks**

1. Select a 5" Stacker square. Sew a rectangle F to oppsite sides of the square  $(8\%" \times 5")$ .



2. Sew a rectangle **G** to the top and bottom of the square to complete the First Round of the block  $(8\%" \times 8\%")$ .



3. Adding a Second Round, sew a Segment D to each side of the block ( $12\%" \times 8\%"$ ).

4. Sew a Segment E to the top and bottom to complete the Second Round and the Block (12½" × 12½").

Repeat Steps 1–4 to make a total of (20) Blocks.

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

1. Alternating positions, sew (5) Sashing Strips and (4) Blocks together side-to-side to make a Quilt Row (58½" × 12½"). Make (5) Quilt Rows.



Quilt Row

- 2. Sew (9) 2½" × WOF strips together end-to-end. Subcut (6) Long Sashing Strips, 2½" × 58½".
  - Note: Seam allowances vary. Measure through the center of your quilt rows to determine an average width before cutting Long Sashing Strips.
- 3. Alternating positions, sew (6) Long Sashing Strips and (5) Quilt Rows together top to bottom to complete the Quilt top (58½" × 72½"). See Quilt Layout Diagram on page 3.

#### **FINISHING THE QUILT**

Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with (7) 2½" x WOF Navy Tonal strips.
