

## ALICE'S PARTY PANEL QUILT

#### FINISHED QUILT SIZE 78" x 86"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

**WOF** = Width of Fabric

**RST** = Right Sides Together

**SNF** = Stitch and Flip

#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

### Dark Panel Teapot

Panel: 1 Navy Alice's Party Panel (P12947-NAVY)

Background: 4½ yards Peony Pin Dot (C705-PEONY)

Knob: 10" square Navy Mad Stripe (C12942-NAVY)

Lid: ¼ yard Pink Rabbit Chase (C12944-PINK)

Teapot Body: 11/4 yards Blush Main (C12940-BLUSH)

Spout: ½ yard Sky Rabbit Chase (C12944-SKY)

Handle: ½ yard Blue Mad Stripe (C12942-BLUE)

Base Riser: ¼ yard Navy Catapillar Floral (C12941-NAVY)

Base: Included in Pink Cards Binding fabric

Binding: % yard Pink Cards (C12945-PINK)

#### **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting Instructions are based on 42" WOF.
- Refer to the guilt cover for the placement of fabrics.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut fabrics.
- Label pieces as you cut.
- Cutting instructions reflect the placement sequence of fabrics in the requirement list. Light Panel Teapot fabrics and their swatches are shown or listed first followed by the Dark Panel Teapot fabrics.

#### **Panel**

Trim the panel to measure 35%" x 43%". Before trimming, ensure there will be at least a %" between the outermost panel illustrations and the trimmed edges of the panel.



#### **Background: Peony Pin Dot/Aqua Pin Dot**

Cut (2) 15" × WOF strips; subcut:

(1)  $15" \times 27\%"$  rectangles M

(1) 15" square V

#### **Light Panel Teapot**

Panel: 1 White Alice's Party Panel (P12947-WHITE)

Background: 4½ yards Aqua Pin Dot (C705-AQUA)

**Knob:** Included in Pink Cards Binding fabric

Lid: ¼ yard Yellow Alice Toss (C12946-YELLOW)

Teapot Body: 1¼ yards Navy Catapillar Floral (C12941-NAVY)

Spout: ½ yard Blue Mad Stripe (C12942-BLUE)
Handle: ½ yard Sky Rabbit Chase (C12944-SKY)

Base Riser: ¼ yard Coral Mad Stripe (C12942-CORAL)

Base: ¼ yard Navy Main (C12940-NAVY)

Binding: % yard Pink Cards (C12945-PINK)

#### Background: (cont'd)

From remaining scraps, cut:

(1) 15" × 8½" rectangle	L
(1) 15" × 3" rectangle	U

(2) 3" squares D

Cut (4) 12½" x WOF strips; from (2) strips, subcut:

(2) 12%" × 27" rectangle W

(2) 12½" square H

From remaining (2) strips, cut:

(5) 12½" squares H

(1) 12½" × 3" rectangle J

(2) 8½" × 5½" rectangles **B** Cut (3) 10½" x WOF; subcut:

(2) 10%" × 27" rectangles E

(1) 10%" × 15%" rectangle From remaining scraps, cut:

(1) 10½"square O

### **Knob: Navy Mad Stripe/Pink Cards**

Cut (1) 6%" × 5%" rectangle.

#### Lid: Pink Rabbit Chase/Yellow Alice Toss

Cut (1) 5½" x WOF strip; subcut:

(1) 5½" x 22½" rectangle. C



#### Teapot Body: Pink Main/Navy Catapillar Floral

Cut (3) 7" x WOF strips.

#### Spout: Sky Rabbit Chase/Blue Mad Stripe

Cut (1) 12½" x WOF strip; subcut:

(1) 12½" x 21½" rectangle



Cut (1)  $5" \times WOF$  strip; subcut:

(1) 5" × 39½" rectangle

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- Refer to the Fabric & Cutting Requirements lists, cover image, and Quilt Layout Diagram for the placement of fabrics.
- Follow diagram pressing arrows for successful piecing.
- Orient the pieces according to their pertinent diagrams. Doing so is essential to following relational instructions such as top, bottom, left, right and so on.
- All angled pieces are constructed using the Stitch & Flip method. This method is described next and referenced in the pattern.



### Base Riser: Navy Catapillar Floral/Pink Mad Stripe

Cut (1) 7½" x WOF strip; subcut:

(1) 7½" x 22½" rectangle

#### Base: Pink Cards/Navy Main

Cut (1) 5½" x WOF strip; subcut:

(1) 5½" x 22½" rectangle




#### **Binding: Pink Cards**

Cut (9) 2½" x WOF strips.

#### Stitch and Flip Method (S&F)

- Place a square right sides together on a base square or rectangle, matching the raw edges in the corner to be replaced.
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the top square across the corner.
- Sew on the drawn line. Trim the corner ¼" from the stitching.
- Flip the top piece away from the base and press. The original corner has been replaced. The base size does not change.




#### Teapot Lid

1. Sew a rectangle B to each side of rectangle A to make a Knob ( $22\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ").



2. Using the S&F method, replace the upper left and right corners of rectangle **C** with squares **D** to make a Lid.





3. Sew the Knob to the top of the Lid to make a Teapot Lid  $(10\%" \times 22\%")$ .




4. Sew a rectangle **E** to each side of the Teapot Lid to complete Row 1 (75%" × 10%").




#### **Teapot Body**

- 1. Sew (3) F strips together end-to-end. Subcut (2) strips  $6" \times 43\%"$ . Sew a 43%"-long strip to each side of the panel  $(46\%" \times 43\%")$ .
- 2. Sew (3) **G** strips together end-to-end. Subcut (2) strips  $7" \times 46\%"$ . Sew a 46%"-long strip to the top and bottom to frame the panel ( $46\%" \times 56\%"$ ).




3. Using the S&F method, replace all 4 corners of the teapot with squares H to complete the Teapot Body.




#### Spout


- 1. Sew rectangle I to the top of rectangle J (a) to make Spout Unit 1 ( $3'' \times 21\%''$ ).
- 2. Using the S&F method, replace the upper right and lower left corners of rectangle **K** with squares **H** to make Spout Unit 2 (b).
- 3. Sew Spout Unit 1 to the left side of Spout Unit 2 (c) to make Spout Unit 3 (15"  $\times$  21½").
- 4. Sew rectangle L to the top and rectangle M to the bottom (d) to complete the Spout (15" × 56½").



#### Handle

- Using the S&F method, replace the lower right corner of rectangle N with square O to make Handle Unit 1.
- Using the S&F method, replace the lower right corner of rectangle P with square Q to make Handle Unit 2.
- 3. Sew Handle Unit 1 to the top of Handle Unit 2. Sew rectangle R to the bottom, and rectangle S to the right side to make Handle Unit 3 (15" × 39½").
- 4. Using the S&F method, replace the upper left corner of Handle Unit 3 with square H, and the lower right corner with square T to make Handle Unit 4.




- 5. Sew rectangle **U** to the top of Handle Unit 4 and rectangle V to the bottom to complete the Handle (15"  $\times$  56½").
- 6. Sew the Handle to the right side of the Teapot Body and the Spout to the left side to complete Row 2 (75½" × 56½).





#### **Teapot Base**

- 1. Using the S&F method, replace the lower right corner of rectangle W with square X to make a Left Base Unit.
- 2. Repeat Step 1, replacing the lower left corner to make a Right Base Unit.



3. Sew rectangle Y to the top of rectangle Z to make a Center Base Unit (22½" ×12½").



4. From left to right in a row, sew the Left Base Unit, Center Base Unit, and Right Base Unit together to complete Row 3  $(75\%" \times 12\%")$ .



#### **Quilt Center**

- 1. From top to bottom, sew Row 1 (Lid), Row 2 (Teapot), and Row 3 (Base) together to complete the Quilt Center  $(75\%" \times 78\%").$
- 2. Sew (4) AA strips together end-to-end. Subcut (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × 75½" strips. Sew one to the top, the other to the bottom of the Quilt Center (75%" × 86%").
- 3. Repeat Step 2 using (5) BB strips. Subcut (2) 2" × 861/2" strips. Sew one to each side of the Quilt Center to complete the Quilt Top. Quilt should measure 78½" × 86½".

#### **FINISHING**

Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with (9) 21/2" x WOF Pink Cards strips.
