





1 ½ yards	Check - Red (B)	2786-88*
1/4 yard	Wagon Wheels with Flowers - Dark 7	Teal (C)

1/4 yard	Tossed Sheep - Dark Teal (D)	2775-67
1/4 yard	Tossed Pigs - Dark Teal (E)	2782-67
5⁄8 yard	Check - Slate (F)	2786-70
3/8 yard	Jot Dot - Brown (G)	9570-39
3/8 yard	Check - Gray (H)	2786-90
3/8 yard	Chickens - Green (I)	2776-66
⅓ yard	Jot Dot - Black (J)	9570-99
4 ½ yards	Farm Border Stripe - Light Green (K)	2784-60
1/4 yard	Flowers on Check - Gray (L)	2779-90
4 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yards	Farm Animal Collage - Gray (Backing)	2780-90

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Farm Blocks - Tan (A):

• Fussy cut (6) 11 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

### From the Check - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 4 ½" triangles.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 11 ½" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 14 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Wagon Wheels with Flowers - Dark Teal (C), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

### From the Tossed Sheep - Dark Teal (D), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

### From the Tossed Pigs - Dark Teal (E), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

### From the Check - Slate (F), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 ½" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 52 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

### From the Jot Dot - Brown (G), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 4 ½" triangles.

### From the Check - Gray (H), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 4 ½" triangles.

### From the Chickens - Green (I), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 4 ½" triangles.

### From the Jot Dot - Black (J), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 12 ½" strips.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 13 ½" strips.

### From the Farm Border Stripe - Light Green (K), cut:

- (2) 11" x 80" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 11" x 67" LOF strips.

### From the Flowers on Check - Gray (L), cut:

• (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 ½" squares.


### From the Farm Animal Collage - Gray (Backing), cut:

• (2) 84" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 84" back.

### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 11 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 13** ½" x 13 ½". Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (1) 4 ¼" Fabric B triangle, (1) 4 ¼" Fabric I triangle, (1) 4 ¼" Fabric H triangle and (1) 4 ¼" Fabric G triangle to make (1) 3 ½" Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (24) Unit 1 squares total.

- 3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figure 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (24) Unit 2 squares.
- Unit 2 make 24
- 4. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square, along the Fabric H sides to make (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (24) Unit 3 rectangles total.



5. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 6).






- 6. Follow Figure 7 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric F square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 1/2" Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 8).
- 7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make a second Unit 4 square.







8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 9-10 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (2) Unit 5 squares and (2) Unit 6 squares.







9. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric L square to each end of (1) Unit 3 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 rectangle to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Unit 7 square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 square.



10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figures 12-13 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Unit 8 squares and (2) Unit 9 squares.



11. Sew (1) 1" x 12 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of (1) Unit 7 square. Sew (1) 1" x 13 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 7 square to make (1) 13 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.






12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Figures 15-16 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Three squares and (2) Block Four squares.



- 13. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 17). Repeat to make Row Three.
- 14. Sew together (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Four square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 17).
- 15. Sew together (1) Block Four square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four (Fig. 17).
- 16. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 13-15, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 39 ½" x 52 ½" Center Block (Fig. 17).



### **Quilt Top Assembly**


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
17. Sew (1) 2" x 52 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 42 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 18. Center (1) 11" x 80" Fabric K strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 19. Repeat Step 18 to sew (1) 11" x 67" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 18).
- 20. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 18), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.



- 21. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 22. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 23. Bind as desired.
