

Finished Size: 64 1/2" x 76 1/2"

♦ Fabric Requirements:

- Block Background: 40 Fat Quarters (Bee Backgrounds) OR 8 yards if using one background (Kimberly is using C747-ALPINE)
- Block Print: 2-10" Stackers or 80-10" squares (Bee Vintage)
- Inner Borders: ½ yard (C6384-HONEY)
- Middle Borders: ½ yard (C13077-DENIM)
- Outer Border Cornerstones: Fat Quarter (C13088-DAISY)

- Outer Borders: 1 ½ yards (C13074-SONGBIRD)
- Binding: ¾ yard (C13077-DENIM)
- Backing: 4 % yards
- 6" Vintage Kite Foundation Paper: Two Pads (#ISE-792)



Cutting:


Fabric		Quantity & Size
Block Background	Α	640 - 3 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles
Block Prints	В	320 - 3 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles
Inner Borders	С	6 - 1 ½" x width of fabric strips
Middle Borders	D	6 - 1 ½" x width of fabric strips
Outer Border Cornerstones	Ε	4 - 6 ½″ squares
Outer Borders	F	7 - 6 ½" x width of fabric strips
Binding	G	8 - 2 ½" x width of fabric strips



Quilt Center:

Assemble Quilt Center. Press open.

Quilt Center should measure 48 ½" x 60 ½".





Inner Borders:


Piece the Fabric C strips end to end.

Subcut into:

- 2 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips (Side Inner Borders C1)
- 2 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips (Top and Bottom Inner Borders C2)

Attach the Side Inner Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Inner Borders.





Middle Borders:


Piece the Fabric D strips end to end.

Subcut into:

- 2 1 ½" x 62 ½" strips (Side Middle Borders D1)
- 2 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips (Top and Bottom Middle Borders D2)

Attach the Side Middle Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Middle Borders.





Outer Borders:


Piece the Fabric F strips end to end.

Subcut into:

- 2 6 ½" x 64 ½" strips (Side Outer Borders F1)
- 2 6 ½" x 52 ½" strips (Top and Bottom Outer Borders F2)

Attach the Side Outer Borders.

Attach the Top and Bottom Outer Borders.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric G strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
