

Α	ASTITCH STATES	51509-X Multi	2/3	(3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew short ends together and subcut (2) 6-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips.
В		51510-2 Blue Print	1-7/8	(7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (3) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" pieces, (2) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces, (3) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces, (2) 2-1/2" x 6" pieces, (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece, (1) 2-1/2" x 4" piece, (13) 2-1/2" squares and (48) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding. (14) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew (10) strips short ends together and subcut (8) 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips. From remaining (4) strips, subcut (96) 1-1/2" squares.

J		51514-7 Green	1/3	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 6-1/2" squares and (2) 4-1/2" squares.
K		40171-22 Tan-Beige	3/8	(2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (48) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces.
L		31835S-White	1-1/3	(1) 4" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 4" x 6-1/2" pieces. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces, (1) 2-1/2" x 7" piece, (2) 2-1/2" x 6" piece, (2) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces, (14) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces, (2) 2-1/2" x 4" pieces, (2) 2-1/2" x 3" pieces, (26) 2-1/2" squares, (8) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces, and (1) 1" x 2-1/2" piece. (1) 2-1/4" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" pieces. (4) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (4) 2" x 14-1/2" pieces, (4) 2" x 2-1/2" pieces and (32) 2" squares. (3) 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew strips short ends together and cut (2) 1-3/4" x 48-1/2" strips and (2) 1-3/4" x 14-1/2" pieces. From remaining fabric, cut (48) circles from template (see p. 3).

Additional Supplies: Fusible web



Rows 1 & 7

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) **B** 1-1/2" squares. Position a marked square on both ends of (1) **K** 1-1/2" \times 4-1/2" piece. Sew on the drawn lines, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press open. Repeat to make (2) spool caps.



2. To make a spool center, sew **B** 1-1/2" \times 2-1/2" pieces lengthwise to opposite sides of (1) **D** 2-1/2" square.



3. Sew spool caps to the top and bottom of a spool center. Repeat to make a total of (8) D small spool blocks. In the same way, make a total of (8) each E and F small spool blocks.



4. Sew (12) small spool blocks together to make a small spool row measuring $48-1/2" \times 4-1/2"$. Make (2).



Row 3

5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) \mathbf{L} 2" squares. Position a marked square in each corner of (1) \mathbf{J} 6-1/2" square as shown. Sew on the drawn lines, trim seam allowances to 1/4", and press open. Make a total of (2) each G, H, I and J button blocks.



6. Trace the circle template (32) times onto the paper side of fusible web. Cut out 1/4" past the drawn line and fuse onto the wrong side of the remaining **L** fabric. Cut out each circle on the drawn line. Fuse (4) circles to the center of each button block. Use a decorative stitch to secure as desired.



7. Sew the button blocks into a row measuring 48-1/2" x 6-1/2".




Row 4

Note: Each letter is constructed in horizontal rows.

8. S Block:

- **a.** Sew **L** 1-1/2" \times 2-1/2" pieces to opposite ends of (1) **B** 2-1/2" \times 6-1/2" piece to make row S1. Repeat to make row S7.
- **b.** Sew **B** 2-1/2" squares to opposite ends of (1) **L** 2-1/2" \times 4-1/2" piece to make row S2. Repeat to make row S6.
- **c.** Sew (1) **L** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" and (1) **L** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece to opposite sides of (1) **B** 2-1/2" square to make row S3. Repeat to make row S5.
 - d. Sew L 2-1/2" squares to opposite ends of (1) B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece to make row S4.
 - e. Sew together rows S1-S7 to complete the S block, measuring 8-1/2" x 14-1/2".




9. T Block: Sew **L** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces lengthwise to opposite sides of (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece. Sew (1) **L** 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece to the top to complete the 6-1/2" x 14-1/2" T block. Make (2).








10. I Block: Sew **L** 2" \times 14-1/2" pieces lengthwise to opposite sides of (1) **B** 2-1/2" \times 14-1/2" piece to complete the 5-1/2" \times 14-1/2" I block.




11. C Block:

- **a.** Sew (1) \mathbf{L} 3" x 2-1/2" and (1) \mathbf{L} 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" piece to opposite ends of (1) \mathbf{B} 2-1/2" x 6" piece to make row C1. Repeat to make row C7.
- **b.** Sew together (1) **L** 2" x 2-1/2" piece, (1) **B** 2-1/2" square, (1) **L** 2-1/2" x 4" piece and (1) **B** 2-1/2" square to make row C2. Repeat to make row C6.
- **c.** Sew (1) **L** 2" x 2-1/2" piece and (1) **L** 2-1/2" x 6" piece to opposite sides of (1) **B** 2-1/2" square to make row C3. Repeat to make row C5.
- **d.** Sew (1) **L** 1" x 2-1/2" piece and (1) **L** 2-1/2" x 7" piece to opposite sides of (1) **B** 2-1/2" square to to make row C4.
- **e.** Sew together rows C1-C7 to complete the C block, measuring $9-1/2" \times 14-1/2"$.




12. H Block: Sew **L** 4" \times 6-1/2" pieces to opposite sides of (1) **B** 2-1/2" \times 4" piece as shown on p. 6. Sew 2-1/2" \times 14-1/2" pieces to opposite long sides to complete the H block, measuring 8" \times 14-1/2".






13. Sew together the S, T, I, T, C and H blocks and (2) \mathbf{L} 2" x 14-1/2" pieces, positioning the \mathbf{L} pieces after the S and C. Sew \mathbf{L} 2-1/4" x 14-1/2" pieces to both ends of the pieced STITCH unit. Sew \mathbf{L} 1-3/4" x 48-1/2" strips to the top and bottom. The row should measure 48-1/2" x 17".




Row 5


14. Referring to the directions for Row 1, use 4-1/2" center squares, \mathbf{L} 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces, \mathbf{C} 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces, and \mathbf{L} 2-1/2" squares to make a total of (6) large spool blocks measuring 8-1/2" square. Make (2) each using \mathbf{H} , \mathbf{I} and \mathbf{J} centers.

















15. Sew the blocks together in a row, noting orientation of the blocks. The row should measure 48-1/2" x 8-1/2".



QUILT ASSEMBLY

16. Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on p. 8, lay out rows 1-7 (rows 2 and 6 are $\bf A$ 6-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips) alternating with (8) $\bf B$ 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips.

17. Sew the rows together to complete the 48-1/2" x 59" quilt top.


FINISHING

Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **B** 2-1/2" strips pieced together using diagonal seams.
