



Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the top right corner. Partial Side Unit should measure

(1 1/4" x 1 1/4") [2" x 2"] {2 3/4" x 2 3/4"}.








Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the opposite end. Flying Geese Unit should measure (1 1/4" x 2") [2" x 3 1/2"] {2 3/4" x 5"}.





Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric F and Fabric H squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on the left end of a Flying Geese Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the right end with a Fabric H square. Petal Unit should measure

(1 1/4" x 2") [2" x 3 1/2"] {2 3/4" x 5"}.

Repeat on the top right corner with a Fabric A square, bottom left corner with a Fabric D square and bottom right corner with a Fabric G square.

Top Left Wing Unit should measure

(1 ³/₄" x 2") [3" x 3 ¹/₂"] {4 ¹/₄" x 5"}.





Make one.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric B squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric G square on the top left corner of a First Wing Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the top right corner with a Fabric B square, bottom left corner with a Fabric D square and bottom right corner with a Fabric A square.

Bottom Right Wing Unit should measure

 $(1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 2") [3" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "] $\{4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 5"\}.





With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square on the top left corner of a **Second Wing Unit**.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Repeat on the top right corner with a Fabric D square, bottom left corner with a Fabric G square and bottom right corner with a Fabric D square.

Top Right Wing Unit should measure
