

## Cutting:

Background 37655-31	A	2 - 6 ½" squares
Tree Print	B	3 - 3" x 6 ½" rectangles
		1 - 2 ½" x 27 ½" strip
	D	5 - 2" x 3 ½" rectangles »
	E	6 - 2" squares
37655-25	E	4 - 1 1⁄4" x 2" rectangles
Bow Print 37655-11	G	10 - 2" squares »

37655-22 37650-28	H	From each Print: 1 - 5" x 6" rectangle (2 total)
37652-13 37650-24		From each Print: 1 - 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle (3 total)







Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Row Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric G squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric G square on one end of a Fabric D rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $1/4^{\prime\prime}$  away from the seam.





Repeat on the opposite end.

Flying Geese Unit should measure 2" x 3 1/2".






Make 5.

Assemble two Fabric E squares and one Flying Geese Unit.

Small Bow Unit should measure 2" x 6 1/2".






Make 3.

Assemble one Fabric B rectangle, one Small Bow Unit and one Fabric I rectangle.

Small Gift Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 7 1/2".





Make 3 total.

Assemble two Fabric F rectangles and one Flying Geese Unit.


Large Bow Unit should measure 2" x 5".





Assemble one Large Bow Unit and one Fabric H rectangle.

Large Gift Unit should measure 5" x 7 1/2".







Make 2 total.

Assemble Unit.


Tucked Under the Tree Unit should measure 9 ½" x 27 ½".






Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A squares.


With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square on the top left corner of the Tucked Under the Tree Unit. Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.






Repeat on the top right corner.

Tucked Under the Tree Row should measure 9 1/2" x 27 1/2".
