

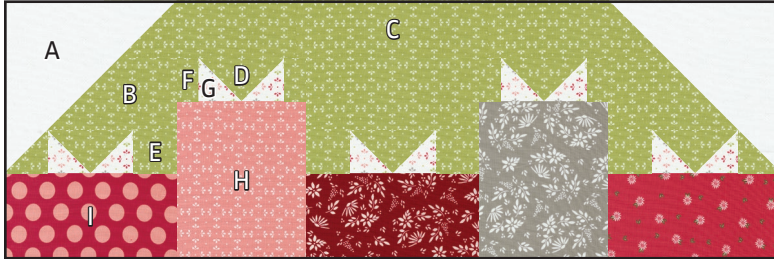

## WEEK ONE — *Tucked Under the Tree Row:*



Unfinished size: 9 1/2" x 27 1/2"




Make 1.






### Optional:

» 1.5" x 3" Flying Geese Quilt Block Foundation Paper  
It's Sew Emma #ISE-775



### Cutting:

<b>Background</b>  37655-31	<b>A</b> 2 - 6 1/2" squares
<b>Tree Print</b>  37655-25	<b>B</b> 3 - 3" x 6 1/2" rectangles <b>C</b> 1 - 2 1/2" x 27 1/2" strip <b>D</b> 5 - 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles » <b>E</b> 6 - 2" squares <b>F</b> 4 - 1 1/4" x 2" rectangles
<b>Bow Print</b>  37655-11	<b>G</b> 10 - 2" squares »

<b>Large Gift Prints</b>  37655-22  37650-28	<b>H</b> From each Print: 1 - 5" x 6" rectangle (2 total)
<b>Small Gift Prints</b>  37652-13  37650-24  37654-13	<b>I</b> From each Print: 1 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle (3 total)

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Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Row Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric G squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric G square on one end of a Fabric D rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the opposite end.

Flying Geese Unit should measure 2" x 3 1/2".



Make 5.

Assemble two Fabric E squares and one Flying Geese Unit.

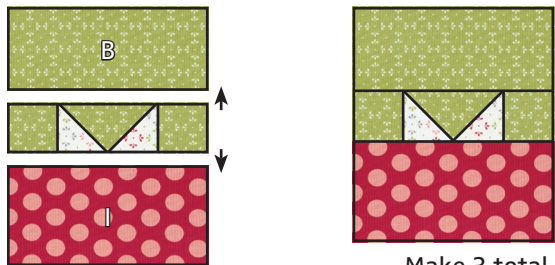
Small Bow Unit should measure 2" x 6 1/2".



Make 3.

Assemble one Fabric B rectangle, one Small Bow Unit and one Fabric I rectangle.

Small Gift Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 7 1/2".



Make 3 total.

Assemble two Fabric F rectangles and one Flying Geese Unit.

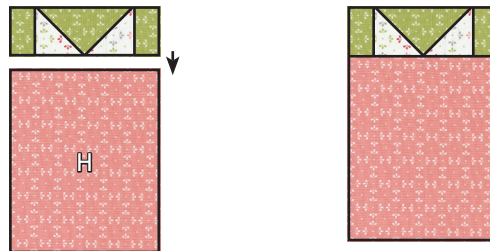
Large Bow Unit should measure 2" x 5".



Make 2.

Assemble one Large Bow Unit and one Fabric H rectangle.

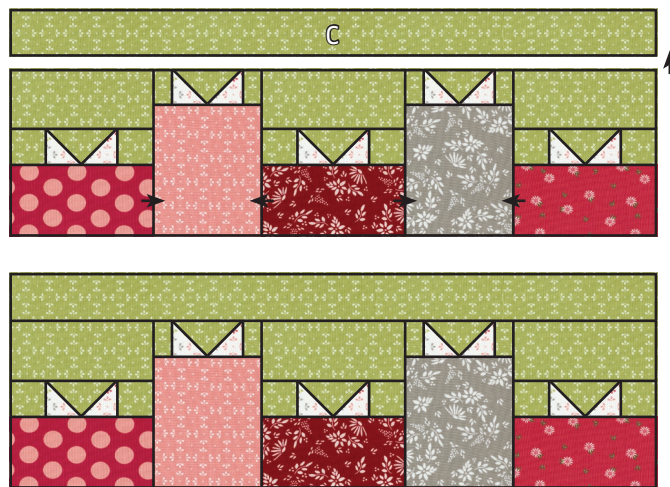
Large Gift Unit should measure 5" x 7 1/2".



Make 2 total.

Assemble Unit.

Tucked Under the Tree Unit should measure 9 1/2" x 27 1/2".

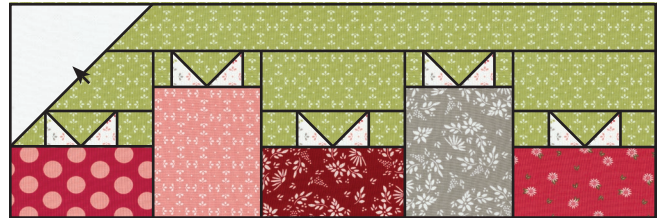


## Evergreen

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A squares.

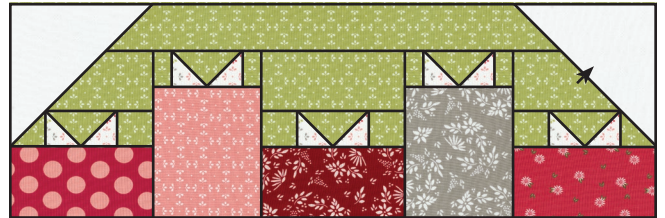
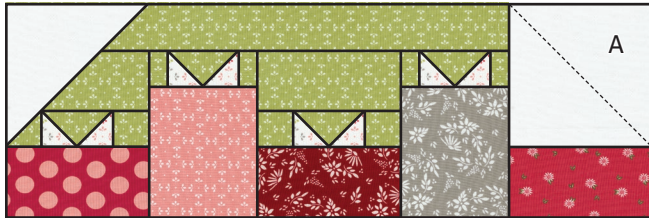
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square on the top left corner of the Tucked Under the Tree Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the top right corner.

Tucked Under the Tree Row should measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $27\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make 1.
