WHITE AS SNOW PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 35 ½" x 54 ¾"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

(1) White As Snow Main Panel (PD13550-PANEL)
¼ yard Red Snowball Toss (C13559-RED)
¾ yard White Snowy Soap Ads (C13554-WHITE)
½ yard Red Scarf Stripe (C13560-RED) for binding

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
1½ yards WIDEBACK backing fabric of your choice

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting instructions are based on a 42" WOF.
- Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.
- Label pieces as you cut.

Panel

Trim the panel to measure 23 ½" x 42 ¾". Before trimming, ensure there will be at least ¼" between the outmost panel illustrations and trimmed edges of the panel.



Red Snowball Toss (Label as Fabric A)

Cut (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips



White Snowy Soap Ads (Label as Fabric B)

Cut (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips



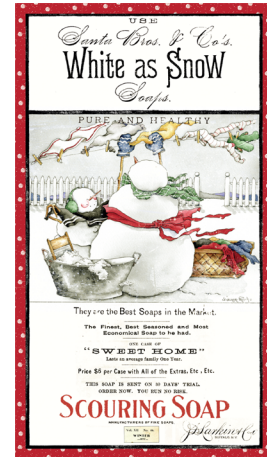
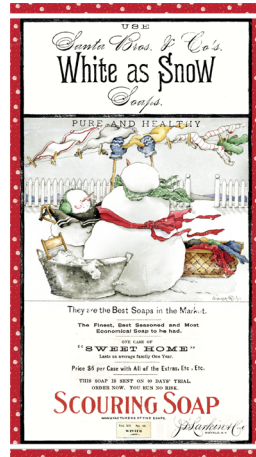
Red Scarf Stripe (Label as Fabric C)

Cut (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding

WHITE AS SNOW PANEL QUILT

INNER BORDER

1. Sew together the (4) Fabric A strips end-to-end.
2. Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{3}{4}$ " borders and sew (1) to each side.
3. Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ " borders and sew (1) to the top and (1) to the bottom.
4. The quilt top should measure $25\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{3}{4}$ ".



OUTER BORDER

5. Sew together the (4) Fabric B strips end-to-end.
6. Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{3}{4}$ " borders and sew (1) to each side.
7. Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ " borders and sew (1) to the top and the other to the bottom.
8. The quilt top now measures $35\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{3}{4}$ ".



FINISHING

9. Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Bind with (5) Fabric C strips. Enjoy and share your quilt using the hashtags [#whiteassnowfabric](#), [#whiteassnowpanelquilt](#), [#rileyblakedesigns](#), and [#iloverileyblake](#).
