FARMHOUSE SUMMER PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 53" x 60½"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

SNF = Stitch and Flip

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics are from the Farmhouse Summer fabric collection unless otherwise indicated.

(1) Farmhouse Summer Panel (P13636-PANEL)

½ yard Gold Plaid (C13634-GOLD) for binding

½ yard Denim Main (C13630-DENIM)

⅓ yard Gold Dots (C13635-GOLD)

⅓ yard Denim Floral (C13632-DENIM)

⅓ yard Red Flower Pots (C13633-RED)

1 ½ yards Sparkler White Sparkle (SC650-WHITE)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

1 ¾ yards Wide Backing

61" x 68½" Batting

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting Instructions are based on a 42" WOF.
- Refer to the quilt cover image for fabric placement.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut fabrics.
- Label pieces as you cut.

Panel

Trim the panel to measure 35 ½" x 43". Before trimming, ensure there will be at least a ¼" between the outermost panel illustrations and the trimmed edges of the panel.



Sparkler White Sparkle

Cut (14) 3 ½" x WOF; subcut:

(64) 3 ½" squares **A**

(8) 3 ½" WOF strips **B**



Gold Plaid

Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF for binding



Denim Main

Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips **C**



Gold Dots

Cut (4) 2" x WOF; subcut:

(64) 2" squares **D**



Denim Floral

Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip; subcut:

(4) 3 ½" squares **E**



Red Flower Pots

Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip; subcut:

(4) 3 ½" squares **F**

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
GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please read through the instructions before beginning.

- Follow the diagrams' pressing arrows for successful piecing.
- The Sawtooth Star's angled seams are constructed using the Stitch and Flip (SNF) method. This method is described next and referenced in the pattern.


STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

- Place a square RST on a base square or rectangle, matching the raw edges in the corner to be replaced.
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the top piece across the corner.
- Sew on the drawn line.
- Trim the corner off, $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line.
- Flip the top piece away from the base and press. The original corner has been replaced and the base size does not change.




SAWTOOTH STAR ASSEMBLY

- Using the SNF method, replace (2) adjacent corners of square A with (2) D squares to make a Star points unit.



- Repeat to make a total of (32) Star points units.
- Arrange (4) Star points units, (1) F square and (4) A squares into a 3×3 setting as shown.
- Sew the pieces together in rows.
- Sew the rows together to complete the Sawtooth Star block.




- Repeat Steps 3–5 using the remaining (3) F squares and (4) E squares as centers for a total of (8) Sawtooth Star blocks, each measuring $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $9 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

BORDER ASSEMBLY


- Sew (2) WOF B strips and (1) WOF C strip together lengthwise to make a Strip Set as shown. Repeat to make (4) Strip sets.




- Subcut the Strip Sets into (4) $13 \frac{1}{2}$ "-wide Short sections, (2) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ "-wide Medium sections, and (2) 18"-wide Long sections.



- Sew (1) Red Sawtooth Star between (1) Medium and (1) Long section as shown to make a Vertical Border. (*Tip: If the seams of the Star block and the strip sets do not nest, turn the block 90° and it should nest nicely.*) The Vertical Border should measure 43 " x $9 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (2).



- Sew (1) Red Sawtooth Star between (2) Short sections as shown, and add a Blue Sawtooth Star to each end to make a Horizontal Border. It should measure $53 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $9 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (2) Horizontal Borders.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Referencing the Quilt Layout Diagram on the next page, sew (1) Vertical Border to each side of the panel, making sure the Long Strip Set section is oriented toward the bottom of the quilt. The quilt top should measure $53 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 43 " at this point.
- Sew (1) Horizontal Border to the top and another to the bottom to complete the quilt top. Quilt should measure $53 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 61 ".

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FINISHING

Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Gold Plaid strips.

Have fun, and enjoy the journey of making your quilt!
