FINISHED QUILT SIZE 36 1/2" x 55 1/2"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates or any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric Press seams toward each outer border strip.

PATTERN REQUIREMENTS

(1) Thread Post Patch Panel (PD13882-PANEL) % yard White Deconstructed Type (C13893-WHITE) % yard White Pattern Making (C13892-WHITE) ½ yard Black Stitches (C13885-BLACK) for binding

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies 1 ¼ yards WIDEBACK backing fabric of your choice 44 ½" x 63 ½" piece of Batting

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Cutting Instructions are based on a 42" WOF.
- Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics.
- Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.



Thread Post Patch Panel

Trim the Panel to 24" x 43"



White Deconstructed Type (Inner Border Strips)

Cut (4) 2 3/4" WOF strips. Join the ends of the WOF strips to make (1) long strip subcut:

- (2) 2 3/4" x 43", label A
- (2) 2 ¾" x 28 ½", label B

White Pattern Making (Outer Border Strips)

Cut (5) 4 1/2" WOF strips. Join the ends of the WOF strips to make (1) long strip; subcut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 47 ½", label C
- (2) 4 1/2" x 36 1/2", label D



Black Stitches (Binding)

Cut (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding

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QUILT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Sew (2) 2 3/4" x 43" A strips RST to the left and right side of the panel.
- 2. Sew (2) $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $28 \frac{1}{2}$ " B strips RST to the top and bottom of the unit. The unit should measure 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



- 3. Sew (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $47 \frac{1}{2}$ " C strips RST to the left and right side of the unit.
- 4. Sew (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $36 \frac{1}{2}$ " D strips RST to the top and bottom of the unit to complete the guilt top. The guilt top should measure 36 ½" x 55 ½".



FINISHING THE QUILT

5. Finish your quilt by layering the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with (4) 2 1/2" x WOF Black Stitches strips.
