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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

2/3 yd Running Yardage (Y0692-4)
 1 yd Stripe (Y0693-4)
 1/2 yd White Plaid (Y0694-1)
 1/4 yd Red Plaid (Y0694-4)
 1/2 yd Red Snowflake (Y0695-4)
 1 yd Green Snowflake (Y0695-25)
 1 1/2 yds Backing of choice
 Fusible web: 3/4 yard

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
 LOF = Length of Fabric

From Running Yardage trim:

1 – 21" x 23" piece

From Stripe fussy cut:

(stockings and candy for the four borders – see quilt image)
 2 – 3 1/2" wide x 29 1/2" LOF strips
 2 – 3 1/2" wide x 27 1/2" LOF strips

From White Plaid cut:

2 – 4 1/2" wide x 36 1/2" borders
 16 – 3-3/8" squares

From Red Plaid cut:

16 – 3-3/8" squares

From Red Snowflake cut:

2 – 2-3/4" wide x 23-1/2" rectangles
 2 – 1-3/4" wide x 23" rectangles
 16 – 3-3/8" squares

From Green Snowflake cut:

5 – 2 1/2" wide x WOF strips (binding)
 2 – 2" x 33 1/2" strips
 2 – 2" x 32 1/2" strips
 16 – 3 3/8 squares
 20 – prepared fusible holly leaves

Making the Pieced Block

1. Pair right sides together a 3-3/8" White Plaid square and a Green Snowflake 3-3/8" square. Pencil a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner (figure 1).
2. Sew a 1/4" seam along both sides of the penciled line. Cut sewn pair in half on the line to make two half square units. Press toward Green Snowflake and repeat to make thirty-two 3" half square units. Repeat to make the same number with the Red Snowflake 3-3/8" squares and the Red Plaid 3 3/8" squares. Press toward Red Snowflake.
3. Layout two half squares units from the two kinds to make a block (figure 2). Sew the units into two rows. Sew the rows together to make a 5 1/2" block. Press the block and repeat to make sixteen blocks.

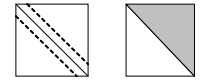

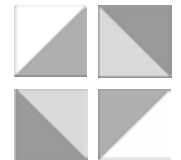

Adding the Borders

1. Sew a 1-3/4" wide x 23" Red Snowflake strip to the left and right sides of the running yardage. Press the seam outward. Sew a 2-3/4" wide x 23 1/2" Red Snowflake strip to the top and bottom of the yardage. Press the seams outward.
2. Repeat to add the 3 1/2" wide x 27 1/2" candy border strip to the left and right sides of the quilt top and the 3 1/2" wide x 29 1/2" candy border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams outward.
3. Repeat to sew the 2" wide x 33 1/2" Green Snowflake border to the left and right sides of the quilt top and the 2" wide x 32 1/2" Green Snowflake borders to the top and bottom sides of the quilt top. Press the seams outward.
4. Arrange and fuse on a 4 1/2" x 36 1/2" green plaid border ten prepared fusible holly leaves as shown in the quilt picture. Finish the appliqué edges. Press the border to remove stitching distortion and repeat to make a second border. Sew the borders to the left and right sides of the quilt top and press the seams outward.
5. Layout and sew together eight pieced blocks into a row (figure 3). Sew the border to the top of the quilt top. Press the seams inward. Repeat to make the bottom border turning the blocks in the opposite direction. Sew the border to the bottom of the quilt top and press the seams inward.

Finishing the Wall hanging

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top and baste for quilting. Quilt as desired and trim away the excess backing and batting from around the outside border.
2. Make the binding from the Green Snowflake strips and apply to the wall hanging.
