## CUTTING:

| 9900-74 | A | 1-61/2" square |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| 9900-36 | [B] | 4-3 ${ }^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles |
| 9900-263 | [C] | $8-31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| 9900-294 | [D] | 4-31/2" squares |

Use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Block Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric $C$ squares.
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square on one end of a Fabric B rectangle.
Stitch on the drawn line and trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the seam.


Repeat on the opposite end.
Flying Geese Unit should measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$.


Make 4.

## \#ULTIMATEBEGINNERQUILT

The Ultimate Beginner Quilt features Bella Solids by Moda Fabrics

Assemble two Fabric D squares and one Flying Geese Unit.
Outer Star Unit should measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{11 / 2 " .}$.


Assemble two Flying Geese Units and the Fabric A square. Inner Star Unit should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Assemble two Outer Star Units and the Inner Star Unit. Sawtooth Star Block should measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
